This year the application requirements are:

- email color wallet size picture of yourself in jpeg format

Please start your application as soon as possible by gathering the required information and seeking two (2) references. One (1) of the two (2) references must be from the Parish Priest (Father Nick Lionas) at St George of Bloomfield Hills. Please begin thinking about how to approach your essay so that you can clearly communicate your ideas and beliefs to the scholarship committee.

For the application to be considered, the completed application package must be received by **April 2nd at 5:00 P.M. EST**. Paper applications should be hand delivered or sent through US Mail to St George Greek Orthodox Church. Digital applications and your photo should be emailed to saintgeorgescholarship@gmail.com.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

The St George Mission Fund offers financial support to qualified high school students in any academic discipline, applying and accepted by an accredited college or university. Trade schools will be considered and must be approved by the Scholarship/Mission Fund committee. The scholarship funds can only be used for educational use, tuition and/or books. The check will be issued on your behalf.

Eligibility requirements:

- Must be of Orthodox faith and a member of the St. George – Bloomfield Hills parish.
- Regular attendance (70% or greater) at:
 - a) Church services - Orthodox Life
 - b) Church activities
 - c) GOYA.

*Regular attendance will be determined by the Parish Priest, Orthodox Life leader and a adult GOYA leader.

- Must demonstrate a strong spirit of community service and good citizenship in line with Orthodox Christian values.
- The scholarship will be awarded with special emphasis on character, scope of interest as reflected in extracurricular activities and evidence in leadership.
- This scholarship is intended ONLY for graduating High School senior students that are continuing higher education or trade school.

The applications will be reviewed by St. George Scholarship Committee Members. The award will be presented at the Graduation Program following the Liturgy on June 4th, 2023. Please save the day in your calendar. The recipient will be notified after the selection process is completed so that he or she can make the appropriate arrangements. If the recipient is unable to attend the services, please arrange for a representative to receive the award on your behalf.
